Club Leo de la Tuque – Centrale Alimentaire.

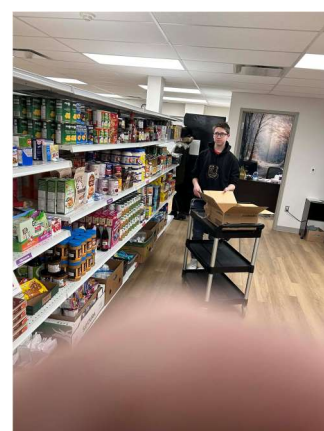

Instead of leaving their used items or clothing at the door, they place them themselves in the bins beforehand identified.

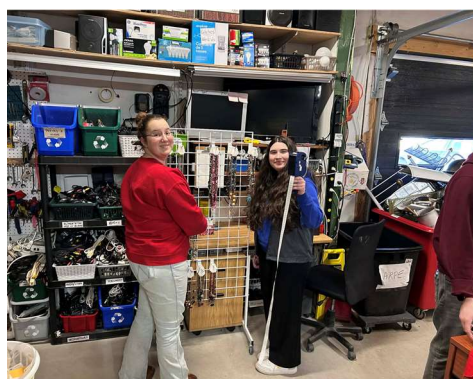
So our young Leo members did the tasks proposed by employees (verification of society, puzzles, clothing classification).



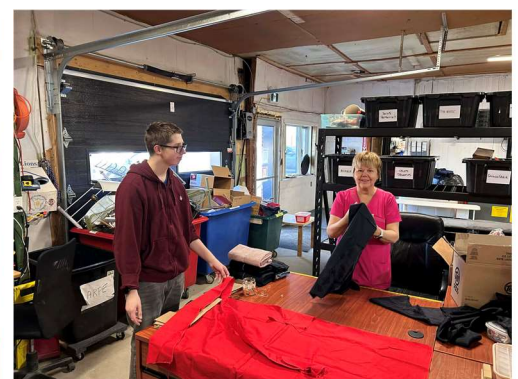

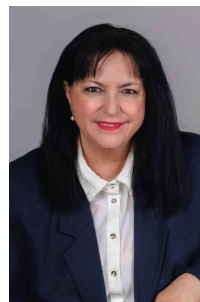
